as far as 400km away from the capital. They crossed Mongolian mountains and rivers to large crowds of devoted Mongolians.

Mongolia was the 23rd country to receive the sacred relics and gold stupa and was also one of the countries that had endorsed the resolution, which was adopted by the United Nations General Assembly on the 15th of December 1999, to recognise the Day of Vesak internationally. They stayed from the 20th to the 30th of August, and the opening ceremony took place at the State Academy Theatre of Drama in the presence of venerable lamas and government authorities.







Recalling:

Following their departure to India in 1959, HE Guru Deva prepared clothing and all the dharma items for HH the Dalai Lama, as well as HH Trijang Rinpoche and HH Ling Rinpoche; He was one of the biggest sponsors of Gelugpas and Tibetan people of our time - HE Guru Deva and HH Dalai Lama were extremely close friends and shared the same teachers.

1963: HE Guru Deva reprints all dharma texts to distribute to all the Gelugpas and worldwide libraries (as for example also



He sponsored all monastic effects and objects to the Amarbayasgalant Monastery, which is traditionally the very seat of the Inner and World Peace Protector Dorje Shugden as Jetsun Dampa the 4th brought the first Dorje Shugden statue to Amarbayasgalant Monastery around the time of the 6th Dalai Lama, and thus is the seat of Dorje Shugden in Mongolia. Each and every Jetsun Dampa is officially recognized by the Panchen Lamas.

Note: Bogot (Bogd) is the highest title conferred in Mongolia.

Both HH the Dalai Lamas and HH the Panchen Lamas have historically very close ties with Mongolia.

The Amarbayasgalant Monastery was founded in 1727. The first King of Mongolia found the site for the monastery to be built some 292 years ago.

Presently the Monastery is on the UNESCO World Heritage Sites list awaiting confirmed listing.

Amarbayasgalant Monastery or the "Monastery of Tranquil Felicity", is one of the three largest Buddhist monastic centers in Mongolia. The monastery complex is located in the Iven Valley near the Selenge River, at the foot of Mount Büren-Khaan in Baruunbüren sum of Selenge Province in northern Mongolia



Ganden Tashi Choeling Monastery

Under the caring patronage of Lama Gangchen Tulku Rinpoche the monastery, settled in Brandenburg near Berlin, is guided by their abbess Lama Dechen Losang Chöma Rinpoche (Mother of Dharma), presently with thirty-three monks and nuns and about forty lay ordained people. Further, the monastery houses Drolma Publications who also translate and edit the publications of Lama Gangchen Rinpoche with great care and distribute them on sale.






Pharmacy

Gangchen Tsering Jong - Gangchen Place of Long Life

Gangchen Tsering Jong is located in the rural farm El Cortijuelo at Busquistar (Granada) in La Alpujarra Mountains in Southern Spain. Located in the Paraje de Los Llanos, one of the highest spots in Spain, it lies within the Sierra Nevada Natural Park and forms part of an ecological reserve.

The Cortijuelo farm is divided into two parts: the old farm (Cortijuelo Viejo) with a total area of 31,756 m2 and containing the ruins of the old farmhouse; and the new farm (Cortijuelo Nuevo) with a total area of 79,865m2 with its beautiful house of more than 300 m2 in perfect condition.

The Sierra Nevada Natural Park is considered by the EU as a Special Area of Conservation (ES6140004) as well as a Special Protection Area for birds (ES6140004), included in the 2000 Natura Network. Since 1986 it has been recognised as a Biosphere Reserve and features in the European Charter for Sustainable Tourism in Protected Areas.

The entire area is considered a BIC (Cultural Heritage Site) and is denominated as a Site of Historic Interest by the Spanish Government.



Lama Gangchen Rinpoche's visit to Tsering Jong (1990)

During the summer of 1990, Lama Gangchen Rinpoche visited the site, celebrating a blessing ceremony and naming it as "Tsering Jong" (Place of Long Life).

In June of 1992, during his teachings as part of the Dharma Holidays programme, on his third visit



to Spain, and his second to Malaga, Lama Gangchen Rinpoche said:

"Now we are in a Dharma Centre in the city, but I do not forget that there is land in the mountains, Tsering Jong - Place of Long Life, which I have visited: a very clean land, very quiet, with its own water source, very pure and with a house half built.

We need to develop that place ... whoever wants can work there to rebuild that ... because, although we are working more in the city, we have to start, always keep that project in our mind, until we find the moment when it is gradually developing and one day, come true. "

After buying the old farm of Cortijuelo Viejo in 1990, we offered it to Lama Gangchen Rinpoche to develop a Rural Centre, without having a very clear ideas of what or how... At that time Rinpoche advised us to start developing a City Centre and to create the conditions for the future. The land remained dormant, used only by goats and horses.

At the end of 2018 some members of our Spanish Sangha were looking for a place in the countryside and their enquiries rekindled our interest in the Tsering Jong land. After collecting the necessary money, we registered the land and pooled its ownership in Josemaria's name, waiting for the appropriate moment to donate the entire property to the Buddhist Community Gangchen Jangchub Ling, NgalSo España.

The pure water spring on the land is co-owned with the neighbouring estate, Cortijuelo Nuevo.



This belonged to Dieneke, a Dutch-British woman, sometime practitioner of meditation, who had lived there for more than 18 years. We visited her to establish the conditions of how to share the springwater and, from the very beginning, she supported our project to rebuild the existing ruin, giving us all the necessary support. Even at our first meeting, out of generosity, she donated to us her rich collection of Dharma books, and her four-wheel-drive BMW that provides the means to move up and down the ancient dirt tracks that in urgent need of remodelling of the area; thus a nourishing relationship of mutual trust began.





Creating the conditionsw to start a Centre
Blessed by double rainbow

Dieneke's dream had been to dedicate her place to a Meditation Centre, so with this conjunction of aspirations between all of us, we started to discuss the conditions of the Centre that would be created. Rinpoche gave very clear guidelines:

"The Gangchen Tsering Jong Centre should be: a peaceful non-sectarian retreat centre, open to people of all spiritual traditions, or who wish to contemplate nature and in relax in the pure environment of the Sierra Nevada Natural Park, to recover their health of body and mind, or to anyone who wishes to stay in a shorter or long-term retreat".

Moreover, the Centre is located in an area that has ample opportunities for trekking along the "caminos reales" or royal highways -- medieval routes, long distance European paths (like the GR-7), and many of these routes are also bridleways and cycle paths.

Finally, to start to run the Gangchen Tsering Jong Meditation Retreat Centre, Dieneke and Josemaria signed an agreement of free use of the both properties, with the Spanish NgalSo Community. Rinpoche express His joy with these words:

Iamso touched and so appreciative of how deeply Mrs Dieneke is embracing all these ideas and understands our mission and is joining by granting the free use of her neighbouring property "El Cortijuelo Nuevo" for the use of the Buddhist Community of Gangchen Jangchub Ling Ngalso Espana. For many years we have been working in this direction, and it is so great that someone recognises this and gives support. In this way our Cortijuelo Viejo and Dieneke's Cortijuelo Nuevo are joining together, as in ancient times they were originally from one family, so now they are returning together with a new spirit, motivated by love and compassion, to work for developing a peace culture, and that is so good.

On September 5th 2019, Rinpoche visited the Centre, where with a group of friends we perform a collective Guru Puja practice. Then we visited the region and slept in a remarkable Hotel (www. castanarnazari.com) in a neighbouring village.

At the Castanar Nazari Hotel, we met the hotel's owner and director, an excellent photographer recently arrived from Mongolia, who shared with us his inspiring graphic work:

Weekly, the Guru Puja and NgalSo Tantric Self-Healing are practised, under the guidance of students of Lama Gangchen.












